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It is hoped that some of the following notes may prove helpful to authors who have kindly consented to write articles for the *Journal*. The editor is always willing to offer further advice, if required, during the preparation of an article.

Time Factor.—The Journal is issued in January, April, July and October and each issue takes approximately three months to produce. Articles must therefore be received by the editor at least four months before the month of issue in order to allow time for correspondence should this prove necessary. Even if received in good time, it may be necessary to hold certain articles over for a subsequent issue in order to create a satisfactory balance of subjects in any one issue.
