OBITUARY—*Continued.*

Captain E. S. NORTHCOTE (Member) joined the Institute in September, 1913. He volunteered for war service, and joined the 11th Battalion Royal Sussex as 2nd Lieut. in October, 1914. He was subsequently promoted to Captain, and when on service in France was killed in September, 1916. Born at Upton Pyne Parsonage, Exeter, in 1884, he was educated at Haileybury, and served his apprenticeship with Messrs. Harland and Wolf, and went to sea in 1908 in the Atlantic Transport Line. He obtained his First Class certificate in 1911, and was afterwards appointed Assistant Superintendent Engineer, which position he held when war was declared. Our sympathy, amid many regrets, has been conveyed to the Revd. Prebendary Northcote on the loss of his son.

WALTER C. SCHOFIELD (Companion) joined the Institute in 1916, and died in December, 1916. He was in the service of Bell's United Asbestos Co., in the Commercial Department, having been trained in the office of the United Asbestos Co. prior to the amalgamation, from 1893, and was promoted for his attention to duty to a responsible position in connection with the Company at Newcastle. After the amalgamation took place he was appointed to a position in London. Mr. Schofield was born at Hull in 1875, and was also educated there.
