At a meeting of Members held here this evening, the Resolutions relating to the Increase of Membership and the introduction of a New Grade, were confirmed.

The Resolutions were proposed at a meeting held here on the 13th March, duly convened in accordance with the Regulations. Copies of the Resolutions, with the necessary fees, have been forwarded to the Board of Trade, acknowledged and ratified.

The limit of Membership is now 1,500, under the Resolution, this limit holds good until a further extension is found necessary.

The New Grade of Membership is called "Companion," and the conditions of admission are in accordance with the circular convening the meeting of the 13th March, and as published in the report of the annual meeting. No alteration or amendments were proposed, the New Grade is therefore added to the Articles of Association and By-Laws.
